INCLUSIVE ELIGIBILITY

Florida Cyber Charter Academy embraces an open access mind set where all middle school students are given opportunities in rigorous courses with scaffolding support for a successful school year. In accordance with Florida State Statute, middle school progression to high school requires students to successfully complete specific courses. Students must pass three middle grades or higher courses in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. One of the social studies courses must be a one-semester Civics education course, with the Civics EOC assessment counting for 30% of the final grade.
