Purpose: **Florida** Cyber Charter Academy provides Internet safety training to all students every year in three areas: appropriate online behavior, social networking, and cyberbullying.

Mission: To educate minors on proper online conduct, including interacting with others on social media and in chat rooms, and to increase awareness and response strategies for cyberbullying.

Policies:

1. Access to the Internet via computer equipment and resource networks provided to qualifying students enrolled in FLCCA is intended to serve and pursue educational goals and purposes. Communications and Internet access should be conducted in a responsible and professional manner reflecting the school's commitment to honest, ethical, and non-discriminatory practice.
2. FLCCA K-12 students will receive internet safety lessons through Navigate 360 on the safety and security of minors when using e-mail, chat rooms, and other electronic communications.
3. FLCCA educators are required to adhere to The Code of Ethics and The Principles of Professional Conduct of The Education Profession in Florida and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) administered by the federal government.
4. FLCCA and Stride, Inc., use protective measures on our virtual platforms/applications and Stride-issued computers that:
 - a. offer protection from inappropriate materials.
 - b. protect the safety and security of students when using application-based email, chat rooms, and other forms of direct electronic communications;
 - c. prevent hacking or unauthorized access by students to data or information that they should not have access to
 - d. prohibit other unlawful online activities by students
 - e. prevents access to websites, web or mobile applications, or software that do not protect against the disclosure, use, or dissemination of students' personal information in accordance with rule 6A-1.0955, F.A.C
 - f. prohibits students from accessing social media platforms, except when expressly directed by a teacher for educational purposes.
 - g. prohibit the use of TikTok and any successor platforms on all district- or school-owned devices, or on any device (including privately owned) connected to district- or school-provided internet
 - h. prohibit the use of TikTok, or any successor platform, to be used to communicate or promote any school district, school, school-sponsored club, extracurricular organization, or athletic team.

As a virtual program with nearly all of FLCCA students using personal computers and ALL of FLCCA students connecting via home/personal internet, these protective measures are not applicable to students' use of their internet outside of FLCCA/Stride applications, platforms, and successor platforms.

If issues arise, Stride IT will evaluate and block unauthorized use.

Internet Safety Ambassador:

The internet safety ambassador will ensure that monthly Navigate 360 lessons have been completed.
